The First Meeting of the Fourth Session of the 7<sup>th</sup> Parliament shall commence tomorrow, Tuesday, 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2020. A total of 20 Bills are expected to be presented to the House. These include;

- Affirmative Action Bill, 2019.
- Rent (Amendment) Bill, 2019.
- Ghana Petroleum Hub Development Corporation Bill, 2019.
- Community Water and Sanitation Agency Reform (Amendment) Bill, 2019.

## 17 Bills are at the Committee level including;

- Legal Profession (Amendment) Bill, 2018. (Committee on Constitutional, Legal and Parliamentary Affairs).
- Intestate Succession Bill, 2018. (Committee on constitutional, Legal and Parliamentary)
- Office of the Special Prosecutor (Amendment) Bill, 2019. (Committee on Constitutional, Legal and Parliamentary affairs)
- Ghana Communication Technology University Bill, 2019. (Committee on Education).

The Ghana Cocoa Board (Amendment) Bill, 2017 which is with the Committee on Constitutional, Legal and Parliamentary Affairs, and the Customs (Amendment) Bill, 2019 with the Finance Committee, will be read a Second time

The Narcotics Control Commission Bill, 2019, the Corporate Insolvency Bill, 2019, and the Land Bill, 2018 are at the consideration stage.

The meeting expected to last 9 weeks approximately, will include a number of Motions for Debate and Referrals at Committee.

Key among the activities is an address on the State of the Nation to be delivered by His Excellency the President, Nana Addo Dankwa Akuffo Addo during the meeting.
